Just incase you haven't caught up with the news, this year's theme for the exhibition is;

**Essentially** Hawkes Bay and the categories are as follows; Bay Folk, Kaleidoscope, Outside the Box - Inside the Bay, Rural, Still Life, The Elements, Urban and the Sculptures category.

The high schools will have their own category again which enter under a slightly different set of rules as their work is done under supervision during their school year. But the competition doesn't end there, there is still the BWR Scholarship open to all artists (except the committee - Aah) so why not put yourself forward for that. It is an opportunity to learn new skills as our

selector, Mary Jessie Sullivan will be showing you the wonderful world of Encaustic Art, creating artwork using hot wax. A fascinating technique from a very capable tutor. Mary will also run a Workshop on Saturday March 23 at the Cheval Room. This is a limited places workshop so book early. \$100 fee should accompany your application.
