## Hello Hawke's Bay artists and friends of Art Hawke's Bay

Welcome to the January 2021 Art HB newsletter. It is 2021 and we hope that there will be no COVID-19 stoppage to our exhibition this time!

#### 2020 Pop-up shop report

- 1. The pop-up shop was run from 23 November to 24 December 2020.
- It was based in the old T & T shop, 119 Heretaunga Street East in Hastings.
- 3. 22 paintings sold which was a little disappointing. A lot of sales were craft items. We counted 1482 visitors.
- 4. We are finalising the last details and it appears that the shop ended up running a surplus.
- 5. The committee will consider if this is worth repeating next year; some other suggestions have been made to promote art in Hawke's Bay. These are also up for consideration after the exhibition.

- 6. A special mention to Helen Dynes who donated a painting of which the proceeds were paid by the buyer directly to Cranford Hospice. Thanks Helen; very generous!
- 7. We would also like to thank the two dedicated organisers, Sheryl Eustace and Winnie Doevendans, who spent a lot of time on organising and participating.

#### 'Artfully Yours' - 2021 Exhibition

- a. The venue: The Hastings Community Arts Centre (Arts Inc.), 106 Russell Street, Hastings.
- b. The period: Monday, 12 April to Saturday 24 April 2021 (Remember that that is almost two weeks and a lot longer than ever before).
- c. The title: 'Artfully Yours'
- d. The categories: Land, Water, People, Abstract, Art Unlimited, Sculptures and Schools.
- e. Art subjects do not have to be Hawke's Bay related.

f. Artists (but not sculptors) must be members of a Hawke's Bay art group or special members of Art HB as per Art HB Rules.

<u>The selectors</u>: John Brown and Susan Mabin <u>The prizes</u>: \$300 for each category except schools which will be \$250. Best-in-exhibition receives \$400.

There is a mystery prize of \$350 as usual, not related to categories or medium, also the People's Choice prize of \$75, both sponsored by JW Picture Framing.

Entries received by 21 March 2021 cost \$10 each. Entries received after 21 March but before 4 April cost \$15 each. Late entries may be accepted in case you can plead special circumstances to the committee. It is all a matter of having enough time to create the catalogue. In all matters, the committee's decision is final.

For your entries you will need to complete the entry form on our website, or the Pdf version, at <a href="https://arthawkesbay.co.nz/2021-exhibition-entry-form/">https://arthawkesbay.co.nz/2021-exhibition-entry-form/</a>. For your entries, you may be asked to complete tags showing: Category, Artist, Title, Medium, Club and Price. (We are working on a faster way to produce the catalogue because our

timeframes are compressed; these tags will be useful.)

Payments: You are asked to record your payment on the entry form. If you paid last year, you still need to enter the artwork details, category etc, then tick on the form "Paid last year's entry, held over".


#### The Art HB workshop
